Spring is a wonderful time to visit the farm. Baby animals are arriving daily, and the plants are blooming. Prairie Gardens offers an exciting and educational tour. This family farm provides a super interactive experience that children will long remember!

Roots, Babies and Blossoms Tour

- **Babies:** *Come meet the new babies on the farm!*
An exciting opportunity for the children to see, hold and cuddle baby farm animals (clucks and chicks, lambs, bunnies, and goat kids) as the babies are born to join our flock! The children may also feed the sheep and goats.
- **Fun Wagon Ride:** *to the Market Gardens and Strawberry Fields.* As we take a tour around the farm to see where food grows, we will explain how we plant our gardens and care for the strawberries. The children will have hands on garden-planting experiences planting seeds, potatoes, and participating in some organic weed control – the bunnies love dandelions!
- **Greenhouse Tour:** *and Gardening ‘Grow-Your-Own-Food’ Educational Presentation. How Plants Grow.* Children are encouraged to sniff and touch herbs, flowers, roots and blossoms. An interactive story with a puppet Buzz the Bee, will help the children learn important agricultural concepts about seeds,

roots, shoots and pollination. Children will plant a Dirt Baby pot with a sunflower or pumpkin seed to take home.

- **Farm Play Areas and Walking Trails.** Spend as much time as you like enjoying our play areas, or going for a farm walk-a-bout! There is a straw-bale maze, Caragana trail, and sand piles to dig in. Enjoy observing the farm pond ducks, and chickens, and alpaca paddock on your journeys.

Hot Dog Roast / Picnic on the Lawn. Have some fun playing old fashioned games like sack races, egg and spoon races. Bring some picnic blankets for the lawn, and enjoy the spring sunshine! Shelter is available on inclement days.

Groups may choose to stay for a BYO brown bag lunch or a BYO Hotdog Roast at the campfire, or you can order food to be delivered to your site.

- Campfire / Group Use Lunch site: cost \$1/person (min \$25.00).
- Order a Hotdog Picnic Pack - Food Delivered to your site: \$40.00 (12 hot dogs, 12 buns, 12 bags of chips, 12 Juice Boxes, 1 bag of marshmallows, condiments, napkins and roasting sticks. (larger groups can order multiple packages).
- Customize a BBQ Hotdog lunch or buffet for all! Buffet menu could include salad, watermelon, cucumber sandwiches, carrot snacks, apples, chips, and juice boxes. Please ask for quote and menu items.

Lunch sites come with a picnic table, firewood, and bales or logs for seating, or in inclement weather, you will be re-located to a cozy greenhouse, where you can eat amongst the flowers. Please bring a beverage and a snack for the children.

This is a real farm experience as well as an educational tour. Come dressed for the weather and prepared for the country outhouses! Sneakers are best, but if it has been raining, rubber boots are recommended.
